Page 168, line 40, at end insert –

- “(c) a feature that turns notifications on by default;
- (d) a feature which enables loot boxes;
- (e) a feature which enables infinite scrolling;
- (f) a feature which enables auto-play of videos;
- (g) a feature which enables time-limited content;
- (h) a feature which enables pay-to-play;
- (i) a feature which enables users to exchange virtual gifts.”

Member’s explanatory statement

This amendment would introduce additional examples of functionalities that can create risk.
