Clause 57

Clause 57, page 49, line 8, at end insert –

“(ab) the combined authority consents, and”

Member's explanatory statement

Clause 57(4) would remove the need for the members of the combined authority to consent to a change in the membership of the combined authority. This amendment would retain the right of members of a combined authority not to have the area covered by the combined authority changed without the consent of a majority of those members.

Clause 57, page 49, line 9, at end insert –

“(c) a mayoral election is not scheduled to take place within 12 months of the order being made.”

Member's explanatory statement

This amendment would prevent the Secretary of State making amendments to the membership of a combined authority in a 12 month period running up to a mayoral election, which could have the effect of altering the prospects of a sitting or proposed mayor being elected or re-elected.
