**5.** Economic Crime and Corporate Transparency Bill - UK Legislation: The Minister for Community Wealth and Public Finance (Tom Arthur) moved S6M-09723—That the Parliament agrees that the relevant provisions of the Economic Crime and Corporate Transparency Bill, introduced in the House of Commons on 22 September 2022, so far as these matters fall within the legislative competence of the Scottish Parliament or alter the executive competence of the Scottish Ministers, should be considered by the UK Parliament.
