Legislative Consent Motion: Online Safety Bill - UK Legislation

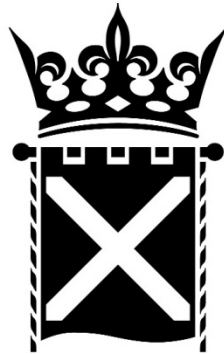

Online Safety Bill - UK Legislation: The Minister for Social Care, Mental Wellbeing and Sport (Maree Todd) moved S6M-09765—That the Parliament agrees that the relevant provisions of the Online Safety Bill, introduced in the House of Commons on 17 March 2022 and subsequently amended to include the new offence of encouraging or assisting serious self-harm of another person, so far as these matters fall within the legislative competence of the Scottish Parliament, should be considered by the UK Parliament.
