Clause 1

Clause 1, page 2, line 10, at end insert –

“(1A) For the purposes of this Schedule, one credit corresponds to 10 notional learning hours.”

Member's explanatory statement

This amendment puts the number of hours that constitute a credit on the face of the Bill.

After Clause 2

LORD STOREY

After Clause 2, insert the following new Clause –

“Review of the provisions in this Act

- (1) The Secretary of State must review the provisions in this Act in relation to the impact –
 - (a) of the credit-based method for determining fee limits on students with a need for shariah-compliant loans;
 - (b) of the credit-based method for determining fee limits on skills gaps in the United Kingdom.
- (2) The Secretary of State must lay the report on the findings of the review before Parliament before the end of 2026.”

Member's explanatory statement

This amendment would require the Secretary of State to review the provisions of this Act and how they interact with stated Government objectives.
