Clause 38, page 21, line 29, leave out from “breached” to “made” on line 30 and insert “a conduct requirement”.

Member's explanatory statement

This amendment would allow the Final Offer Mechanism to be initiated by the CMA after a Conduct Requirement of the type allowed under 20(2)(a) has first been breached, and the other conditions in Clause 38 are met (including the condition that the CMA could not satisfactorily address the breach within a reasonable time frame by exercising any of its other digital markets functions).
