2 Clause 1, page 1, line 16, after "order" insert ", an arbitration award or a settlement agreement"

#### Member's explanatory statement

This amendment ensures that the definition of litigation funding agreement includes agreements under which a funder agrees to pay costs relating to litigation that arise by virtue of an arbitration award or a settlement agreement, as well as by virtue of a costs order.

## LORD MARKS OF HENLEY-ON-THAMES

3★ After Clause 1, insert the following new Clause –

#### "Review: enforceability of litigation funding agreements

- (1) The Lord Chancellor must establish an independent review of the impact of provisions in this Act about the enforceability of litigation funding agreements in England and Wales on
  - (a) safeguards available for claimants,
  - (b) regulation of the third-party litigation funding sector,
  - (c) the level of returns made to funders,
  - (d) available alternatives to litigation funding agreements, and
  - (e) any other matters that are considered relevant.
- (3) The review must be completed by 31 August 2025.
- (4) Within three months of receiving the review, the Lord Chancellor must lay a response before Parliament."

#### Member's explanatory statement

This probing amendment aims to establish a review of the impact of provisions in this Act about the enforceability of litigation funding agreements and explore the scope of such a review.
