After Clause 1

LORD DE CLIFFORD
BARONESS HAYMAN OF ULLOCK

- 1 After Clause 1, insert the following new Clause—
- “Regulations about extension to list of relevant livestock**
- (1) An appropriate national authority may by regulations amend the list of “relevant livestock” in section (1).
 - (2) “Appropriate national authority” in relation to the power under subsection (1), means—
 - (a) the Secretary of State;
 - (b) the Scottish Ministers, so far as provision made by the regulations would be within the legislative competence of the Scottish Parliament if contained in an Act of that Parliament;
 - (c) the Welsh Ministers, so far as provision made by the regulations would be within the legislative competence of Senedd Cymru if contained in an Act of Senedd Cymru.
 - (3) The Secretary of State may not make a statutory instrument containing regulations under subsection (1) unless a draft of the instrument has been laid before, and approved by a resolution of, each House of Parliament.
 - (4) The Welsh Ministers may not make a statutory instrument containing regulations under subsection (1) unless a draft of the instrument has been laid before, and approved by a resolution of, Senedd Cymru.
 - (5) Regulations made by the Scottish Ministers under subsection (1) are subject to the affirmative procedure (see section 29 of the Interpretation and Legislative Reform (Scotland) Act 2010).”

Member's explanatory statement

This amendment would allow the appropriate national authority to extend, by statutory instrument subject to the affirmative procedure, the list of livestock species which may not be exported for slaughter.

After Clause 6

BARONESS BAKEWELL OF HARDINGTON MANDEVILLE

2 After Clause 6, insert the following new Clause—

“Review of the impact on farming

Within six months of the day on which this Act is passed, the Secretary of State must publish and lay before Parliament a review of the impact of this Act on farming in Great Britain.”

Clause 7

LORD DE CLIFFORD

3 Clause 7, page 5, line 27, at end insert—

- “(3A) Section (*Regulations about extension to list of relevant livestock*) comes into force on such day as may be appointed by regulations made by—
- (a) in relation to England, the Secretary of State;
 - (b) in relation to Scotland, the Scottish Ministers;
 - (c) in relation to Wales, the Welsh Ministers.”

Member's explanatory statement

This amendment is consequential to the new Clause (Regulations about extension to list of relevant livestock) tabled in the name of Lord de Clifford.
