Legislative Consent Motion: Data Protection and Digital Information Bill - UK Legislation

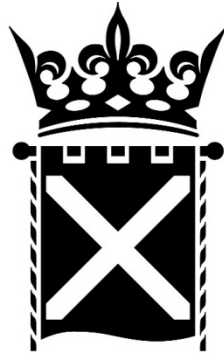
