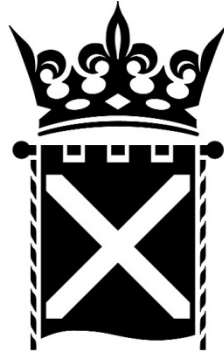

Passenger Railway Services (Public Ownership) Bill - UK Legislation:** The Cabinet Secretary for Transport (Fiona Hyslop) moved S6M-15088—That the Parliament agrees that all relevant provisions of the Passenger Railway Services (Public Ownership) Bill, introduced in the House of Commons on 18 July 2024, so far as these matters alter the executive competence of the Scottish Ministers, should be considered by the UK Parliament.
