Legislative Consent Motion: Children's Wellbeing and Schools Bill - UK Legislation

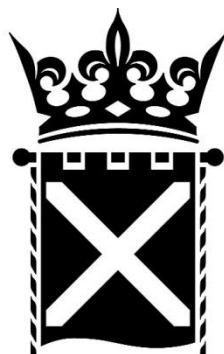

11. **Children's Wellbeing and Schools Bill - UK Legislation:** The Minister for Children, Young People and The Promise (Natalie Don-Innes) moved S6M-18081— That the Parliament agrees that the relevant provisions of the Children's Wellbeing and Schools Bill, introduced in the House of Commons on 17 December 2024, and subsequently amended, affecting child employment and community-based and secure accommodation, so far as these matters fall within the legislative competence of the Scottish Parliament and alter the executive competence of the Scottish Ministers, should be considered by the UK Parliament.
