Legislative Consent Motion: Product Regulation and Metrology Bill - UK Legislation

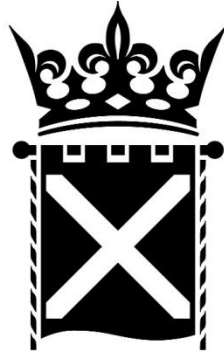
