1 Procedure for making licensing hours orders

In section 197 of the Licensing Act 2003 (regulations and orders) –

- (a) in subsection (3), omit paragraph (d);
- (b) in subsection (4), omit "(d),";
- (c) omit subsection (5).

2 Extent, commencement and short title

- (1) This Act extends to England and Wales only.
- (2) This Act comes into force on the day on which it is passed.
- (3) This Act may be cited as the Licensing Hours Extensions Act 2025.
