Clause 11

LORD FULLER

5A★ Clause 11, page 8, line 26, at end insert –

“(4A) For the purposes of consultation under subsection (4)(h), “P&I Clubs” means any provider of mutual maritime insurance under the Marine Insurance Act 1906.”

Member's explanatory statement

This amendment provides a definition of “P&I clubs” for the purpose of consultation required by an earlier amendment in the name of Lord Fuller.

After Clause 13

LORD CALLANAN

7A★ After Clause 13, insert the following new Clause –

“Report: impact of Chinese industrial fishing on biodiversity beyond national jurisdiction

- (1) Within six months of the day on which this Act is passed, the Secretary of State must publish a report on the harms to marine biodiversity beyond national jurisdiction caused by Chinese industrial fishing and the potential benefits of the introduction of marine protected areas which are beyond national jurisdiction in limiting those effects.
- (2) The Secretary of State must lay a copy of the report under subsection (1) before Parliament.”

Member's explanatory statement

This probing amendment seeks to understand what consideration ministers have given to the harms of Chinese industrial fishing and the positive effects of any future marine protected areas which are beyond national jurisdiction in limiting those harms.
