12A★ Clause 4, page 3, line 4, at end insert—

“(2A) A person is within this subsection if—

- (a) they hold a primary medical qualification awarded by an Irish medical school,
- (b) the qualification was awarded following study at an overseas campus of that medical school that is extant on the day on which the Act is passed, and
- (c) the programme of study in the overseas campus is approved by the Irish Medical Council as—
 - (i) identical in content, standards and assessment to the programme undertaken in Ireland, or
 - (ii) equivalent to a primary Irish qualification where degree holders spend at least 50% of their training for the qualification in Ireland.”

Member's explanatory statement

This amendment seeks to ensure that medical graduates of an Irish institution are included in the priority group, even if the course is not wholly studied in Ireland. This would only apply where their course is identical or equivalent to a programme studied in Ireland.
