After Clause 22

BARONESS LAWLOR

As an amendment to Amendment 552A

After paragraph (b) insert –

“(ba) do not keep the approved drugs on the premises, but order them on a case-by-case basis,”

Member's explanatory statement

This amendment develops Baroness Hollins' amendment 552A designed to reduce the dangers of supplies of lethal substances being stored in easily identifiable locations.

Clause 27

BARONESS FINLAY OF LLANDAFF

Clause 27, page 23, line 4, leave out “one or more drugs or other substances” and insert “lethal doses of one or more drugs or other substances including gases”

BARONESS HOLLINS

As an amendment to Amendment 624A

In subsection (1A), after paragraph (e), insert –

“(f) the recommendations of the Medicines and Healthcare products Regulatory Agency and, where the substance is a controlled drug, the Home Office.”

Member's explanatory statement

This amendment requires the Secretary of State, when specifying a substance in regulations under subsection (1), to have regard to recommendations of the Medicines and Healthcare products Regulatory Agency and, where relevant, the Home Office, in relation to the listed matters.

Clause 37

BARONESS HOLLINS

As an amendment to Amendment 708A

In subsection (5A) leave out “may” and insert “must”

BARONESS HOLLINS

As an amendment to Amendment 708A

After paragraph (a)(iii) insert –

- “(aa) report to the Medicines and Healthcare products Regulatory Agency on matters within its remit;”

Member's explanatory statement

This amendment requires the Secretary of State to establish a committee advising on substances and devices and requires the committee to report to the Medicines and Healthcare products Regulatory Agency.
