“(14) None of the actions described in or authorised by this section may be carried out in a prison.”

716A★ Clause 38, page 29, line 38, at end insert “, unless the provision of assistance under that Act took place in a prison”

Member's explanatory statement

This amendment seeks to ensure that any assisted deaths that take place in prisons are still subject to existing coronial proceedings.

Clause 49

THE LORD BISHOP OF GLOUCESTER

807A★ Clause 49, page 37, line 20, at end insert –

“(3A) The annual report must also include information regarding the number of applicants who, at time of applying, were in prison, and of these the number of those applications which –

- (a) progressed to the panel stage,
- (b) were considered by a panel which were approved, and
- (c) resulted in the person receiving assistance to die in prison.”

Member's explanatory statement

This amendment seeks to ensure that the number of prisoners who receive assistance is monitored.
